The event is tentatively scheduled **from Thursday, October 30 to Friday, October 31.**

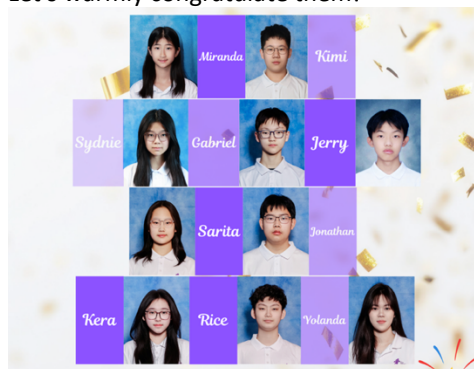

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International Day

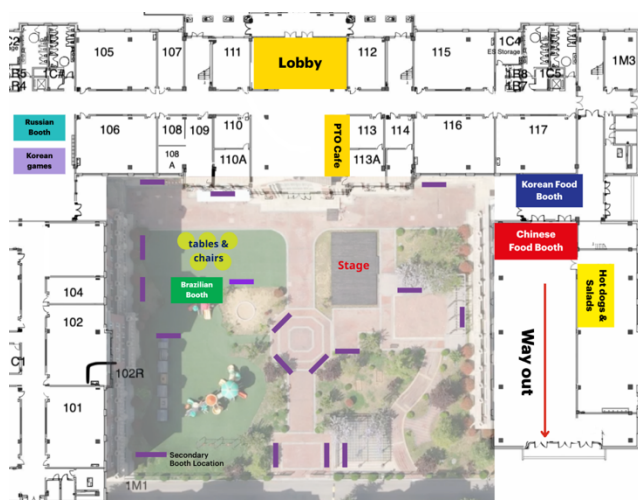
